The 1896 V. Henry Rothschild & Co. factory was built to manufacture shirts, and was later used for making luggage by the Atlantic Products Corporation. It is now a “hip” adaptive reuse offering flex space to local artists, non profits and small businesses.

The second stop:

Grounds For Sculpture, which was founded by Artist and Philanthropist, Seward Johnson. It is a lush 42 acre Museum, Sculpture Garden and Arboretum. Self guided tour.
