



BAG UP NJ



Effective May 4, 2022, NJ Law will ban *single use plastic bags* at all retail stores, food service businesses and grocery stores, as well as *paper bags* at grocery stores at or larger than 2,500 square feet. The law also bans food service businesses from providing *polystyrene foam* food containers.

As of November 4, 2021, *plastic straws* will only be available upon a customer's request.

A REUSABLE CARRYOUT BAG IS DEFINED AS A BAG THAT IS:

- Made of polypropylene fabric, PET nonwoven fabric, nylon, cloth, hemp product, or other washable fabric; and
- Has stitched handles, not glued; and
- Is designed and manufactured for multiple reuses; and
- Is capable of withstanding multiple washes while maintaining usefulness and integrity; and
- Has a minimum of 125 uses.
